Care & Cleaning Instructions

ALWAYS turn off and/or unplug fixtures prior to cleaning.

<u>Portable Lamps</u>: Lamps should be cleaned with a dry, soft cloth.

<u>Finishes</u>: To avoid damage to the finish do not use polish, abrasive cleaners, or harsh chemicals.

Aged Brass (AGB) fixtures: should be handled with clean hands or gloves to avoid uneven patina.

<u>Fabric Shades</u>: Shades can be gently dusted with a soft-bristle brush vacuum attachment., or manually with a dry, clean, soft-bristle brush. Dust in long, smooth strokes from the top of the shade to the bottom. Remember to clean the inside of the lampshade as well. Do not use a brush or a vacuum attachment if there are any rips or tears in the fabric.

<u>Acrylic Diffusers</u>: Use only water or cleaners specifically formulated for cleaning plastics. Always use a soft, damp cloth to avoid scratching the acrylic. Do not use ammoniabased cleaners (e.g. Windex®), abrasives, or chemicals, as they can damage the fixture.

<u>Replacement Lightbulbs</u>: Only use HVLG suggested bulb sizes to ensure proper functioning and extend fixture longevity. Go to HVLGroup.com to find your bulb size and view product details and specifications.
